

LEGAL BASIS

1. Categories

- a. Six categories are defined in which nominations can be submitted for the RENMAD HIDROGENO 2026 Awards
- b. The awards will recognize the value of the nominees' actions during the course of 2025

2. Nomination process

- a. Candidates may nominate themselves and others they consider deserving of the award in each category
- b. Nominations will be made by filling out a nomination form available on the website
- c. Specific information will be requested from each project and nominee as to why the nominee deserves to qualify:
 - i. Organization responsible for the nominated project
 - ii. A maximum of 100 words explanation of the nominee project and its relevance to the category for which it is being nominated

3. Beneficiaries

- a. Candidates may be individuals or legal entities that have stood out for their work in the field of green hydrogen
- b. Candidates must have carried out their activities in Iberian Peninsula and/or have their headquarters in the national territory, with the exception of the categories that provide otherwise

4. Format and Voting

- a. The format of the RENMAD HIDROGENO 2026 Awards is popular, the nominations and election, both finalists and winners, will be made with the votes of individuals
- b. Only one vote per person will be counted, and the voter will receive an email confirming his or her vote

5. Selection of finalists

- a. No person may be a finalist in more than one of the individual award categories. These are:
 - i. Renewable Energy Personality of the Year
 - ii. Renewable Energy Woman of the Year
- b. If the same person has been nominated for two individual awards and obtains enough nominations to be a finalist in both, they will become a finalist in the category with the most votes

6. Selection of awards recipients

- a. The same company or organization may not be the recipient of more than one award. In the event that the nominated organization wins more than one category, it will be awarded only the category in which it receives the most votes
