

Participation Guidelines: III Edition RENMAD Storage Italia Awards 2027 (9 Feb, Bologna)

1. Award Categories

- a) The RENMAD STORAGE ITALIA 2027 Awards feature six distinct categories open for nominations.
- b) The awards recognise outstanding achievements and contributions made by nominees throughout the course of 2026.

2. The Nomination Process

- a) Individuals and organisations are welcome to nominate themselves or put forward any other candidates they believe deserve recognition in each category.
- b) All nominations must be submitted via the official online form available on the event website.
- c) To complete a submission, applicants must provide specific details demonstrating why the nominee qualifies for the award, including:
 - i. The name of the organisation responsible for the nominated project.
 - ii. A brief summary (maximum 100 words) explaining the project or profile and its relevance to the chosen category.

3. Eligibility Criteria

- a) Nominations are open to individuals and corporate entities that have demonstrated exceptional work within the energy storage sector.
- b) To be eligible, candidates must operate primarily within Italy or have their corporate headquarters located in Italian territory, unless specified otherwise in the category criteria.

4. Voting Format and Validation

- a) The RENMAD STORAGE ITALIA 2027 Awards rely on public voting, meaning that nominations, finalists, and ultimate winners are entirely determined by individual votes.
- b) To ensure fairness, voting is limited to one vote per person. Each voter will receive a verification email to confirm and validate their entry.

5. Selecting Finalists

- a) No single candidate can be selected as a finalist in more than one individual category. Individual categories are limited to:
 - i. Personality of the Year
 - ii. Woman of the Year
- b) If a candidate secures enough votes to become a finalist in both individual categories, they will only proceed as a finalist in the category where they received the higher number of votes.

6. Selecting Winners

- a) To ensure a diverse celebration of the industry, a single company or organisation cannot win more than one award. If an organisation wins in multiple categories, they will be awarded the trophy only for the category in which they received the highest absolute number of votes.
